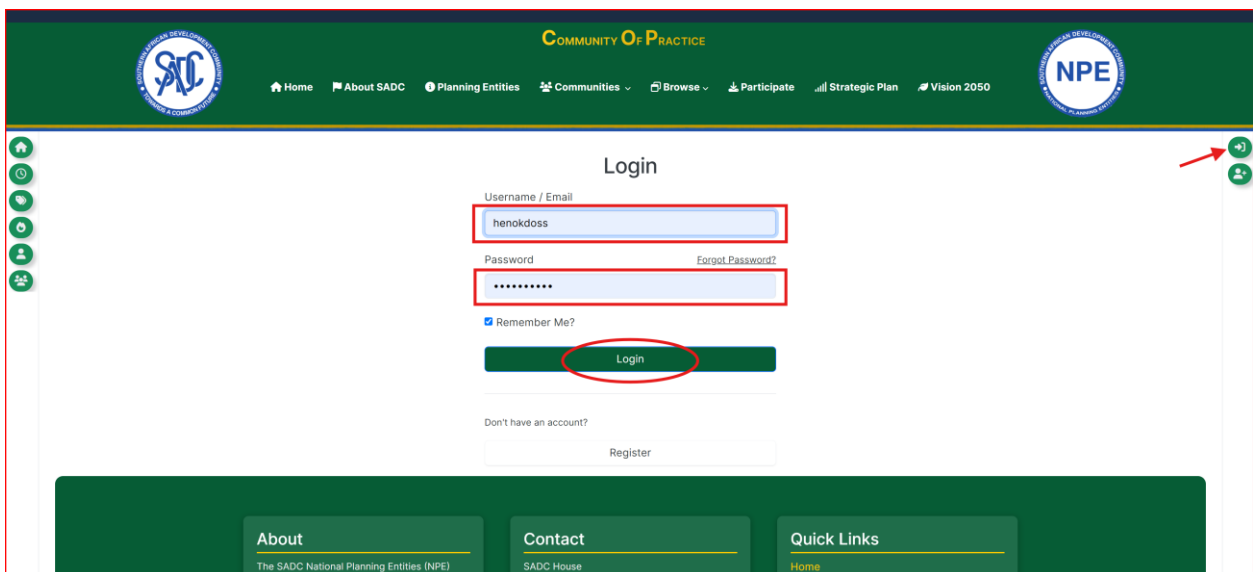



Figure 3-1 Login Screen

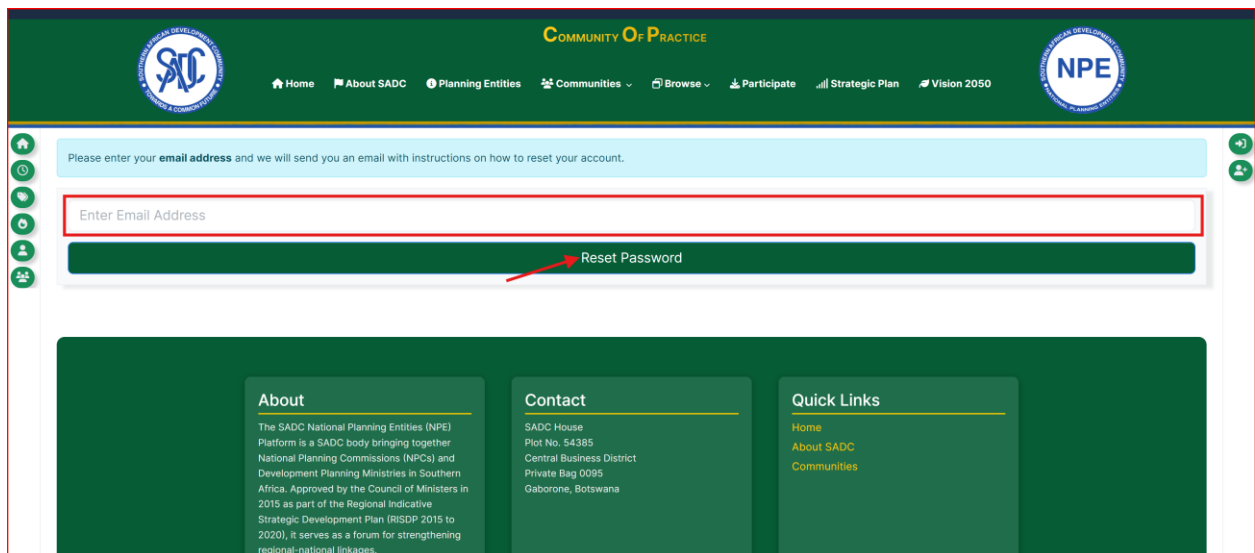


Figure 3-2 Update Password Screen

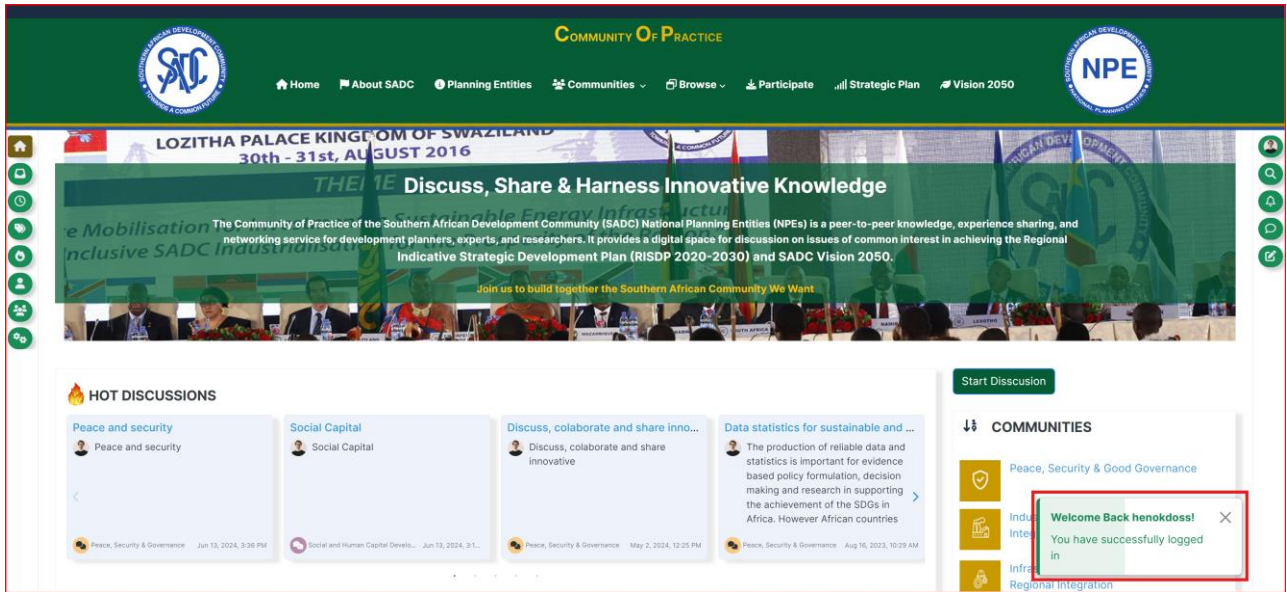


Figure 3-3 Dashboard

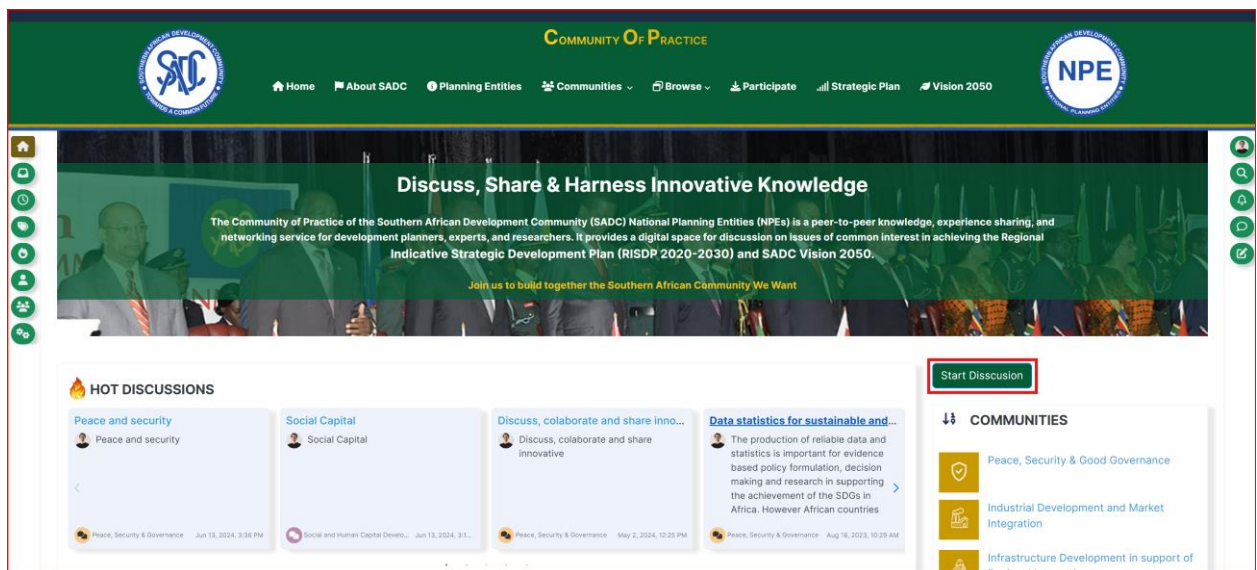


Figure 4-1 Menu

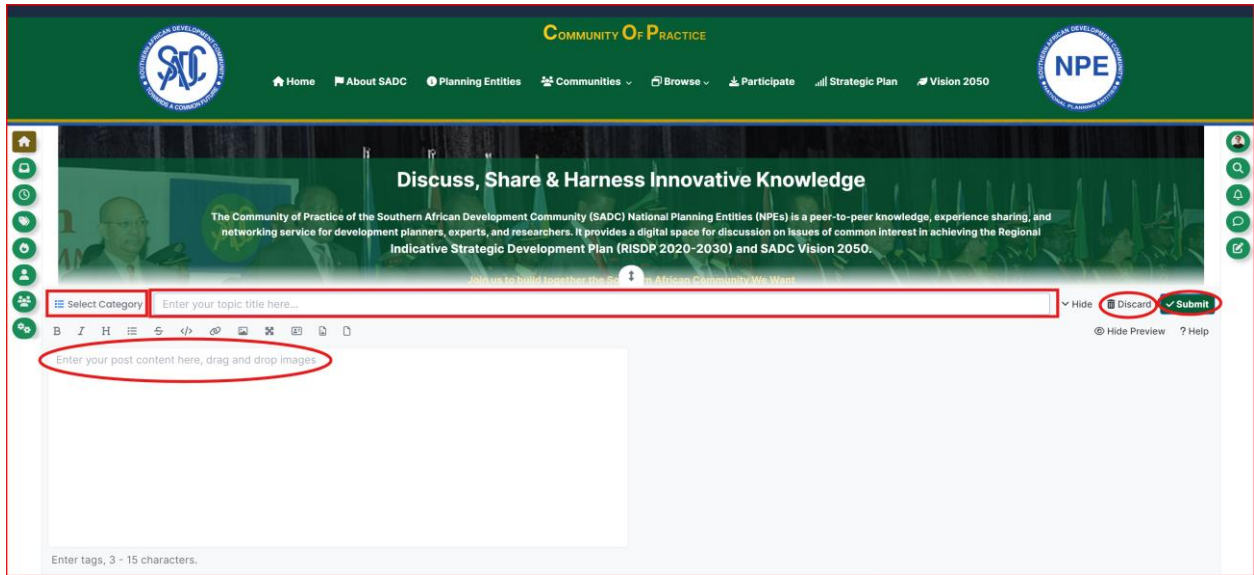


Figure 4-2 Add Create a Post

- Click the **Submit** button.

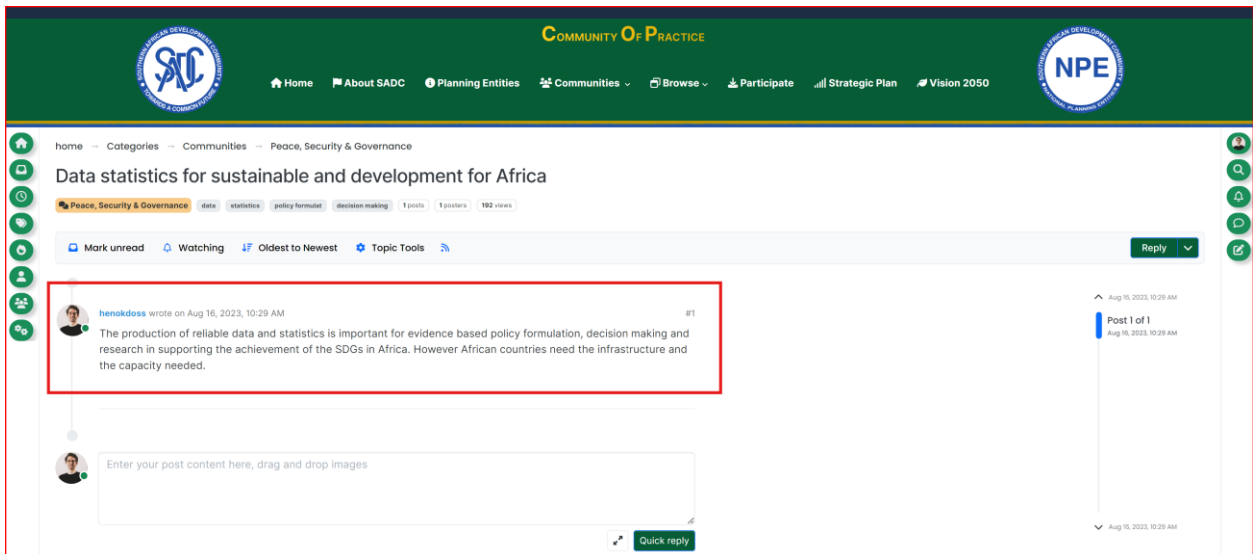


Figure 4-3 View Post

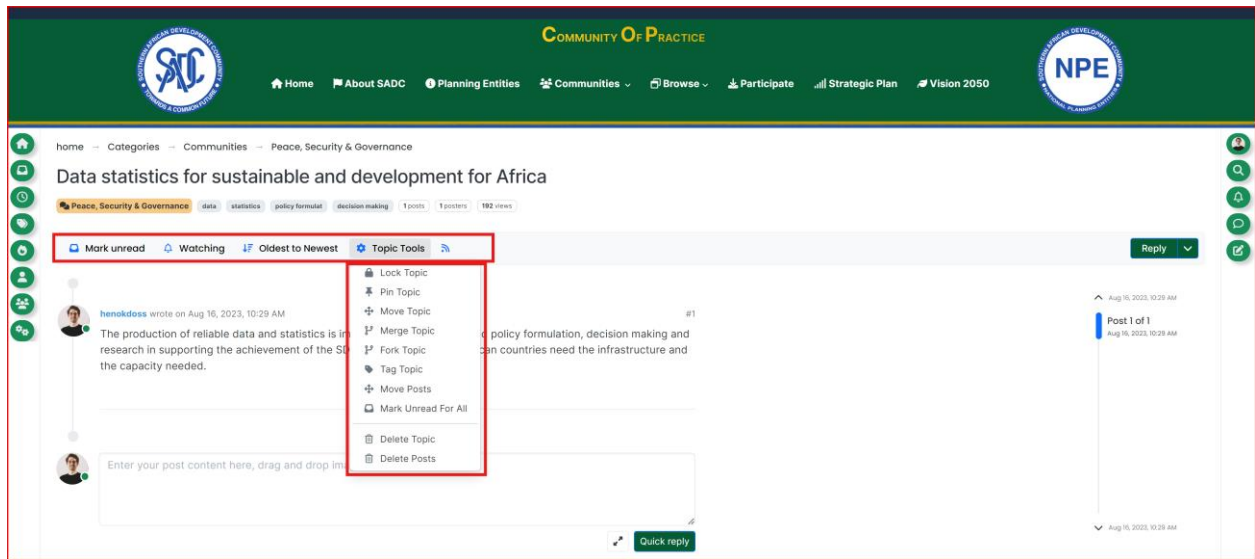



Figure 4-4 Post tools

As you can see on Fig 4-4, there are red box which shows the tools that we are using for usability

- **Mark unread:** feature allows users to mark previously read messages or notifications as unread.
- **Watching:** Enables you to follow a discussion or topic and receive notifications when new posts or updates occur.
- **Oldest to Newest:** Sorts posts or messages in a thread by displaying the oldest content first, making it easier to follow the chronological order of the conversation.
- **Topic Tools**
 - **Lock Topic:** Prevents further posts or replies in a topic, locking it for viewing only.
 - **Pin Topic:** Keeps a topic at the top of the list for visibility, regardless of new content in other topics.
 - **Move Topic:** Transfers the entire topic to another category or section.
 - **Merge Topic:** Combines two or more topics into a single thread.
 - **Fork Topic:** Splits a topic into two separate discussions for better organization.
 - **Tag Topic:** Adds labels or tags to categorize the topic for easier searching and filtering.
 - **Move Post:** Moves individual posts to another topic or section.
 - **Mark Unread for all:** Marks the topic as unread for all participants, making it easier to revisit later.

- **Delete Topic:** Permanently removes a topic and all its associated posts.
- **Delete Post:** Permanently removes an individual post from a topic.



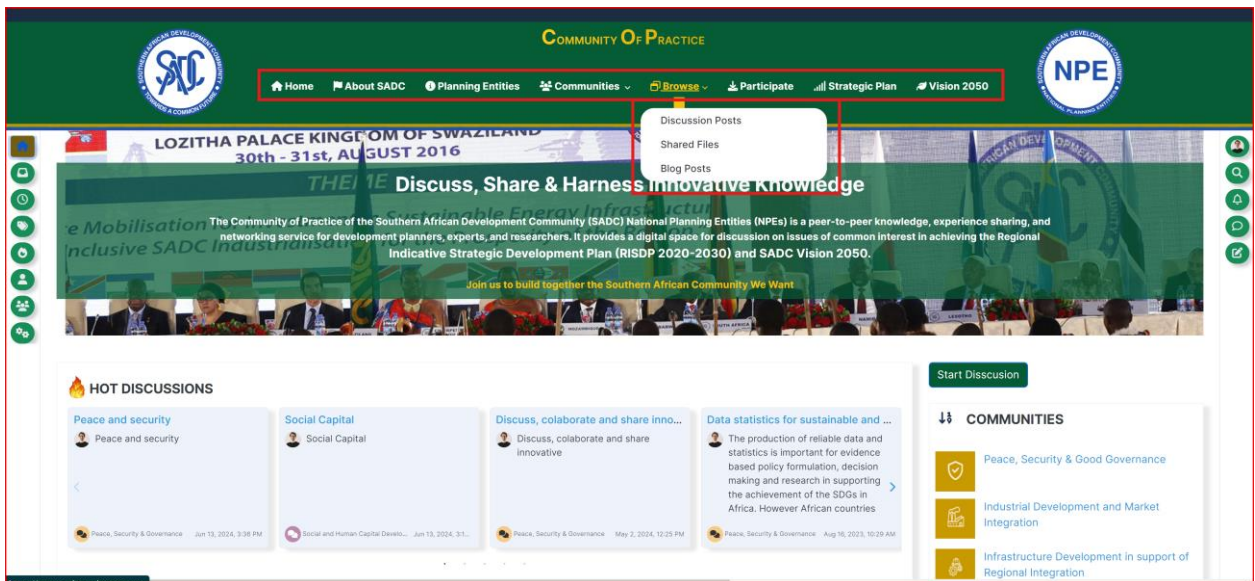
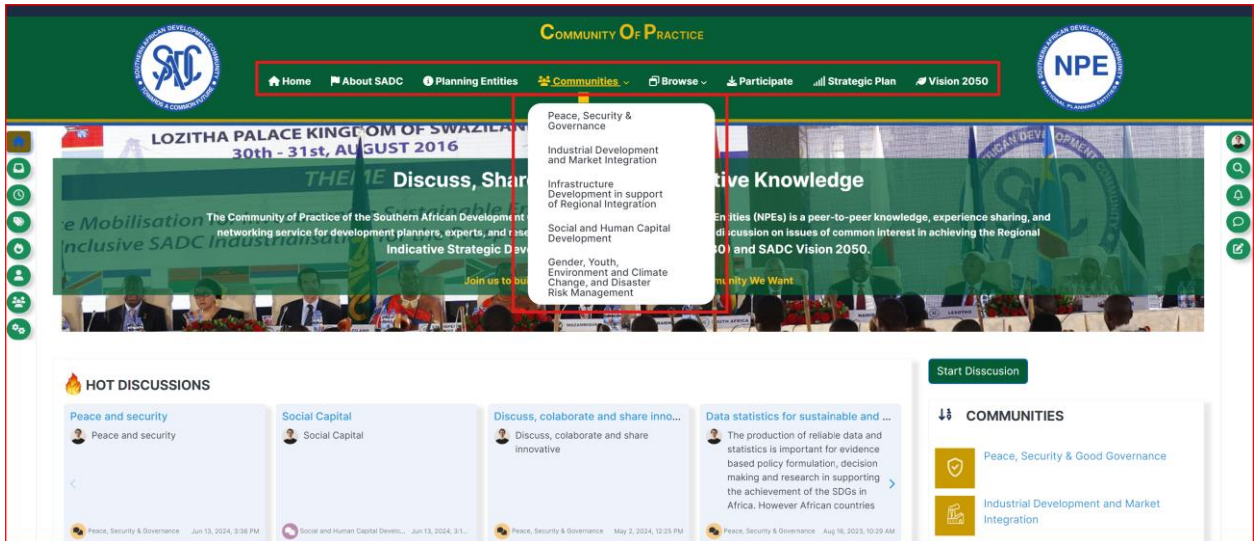



Figure 4-7 Menu

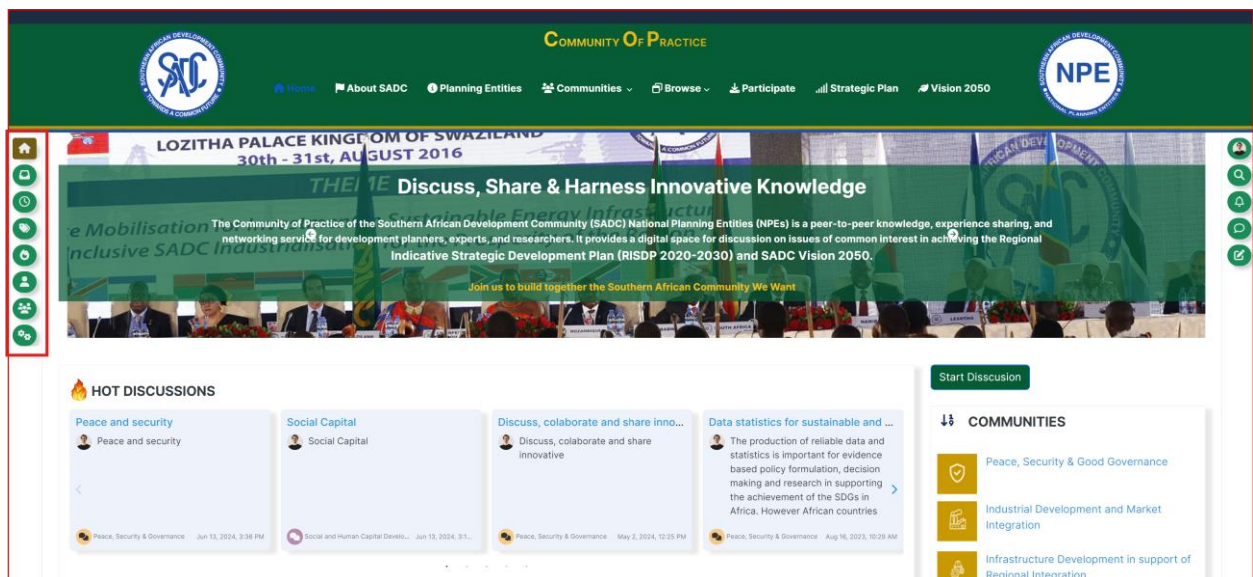











Figure 4-8 Menu

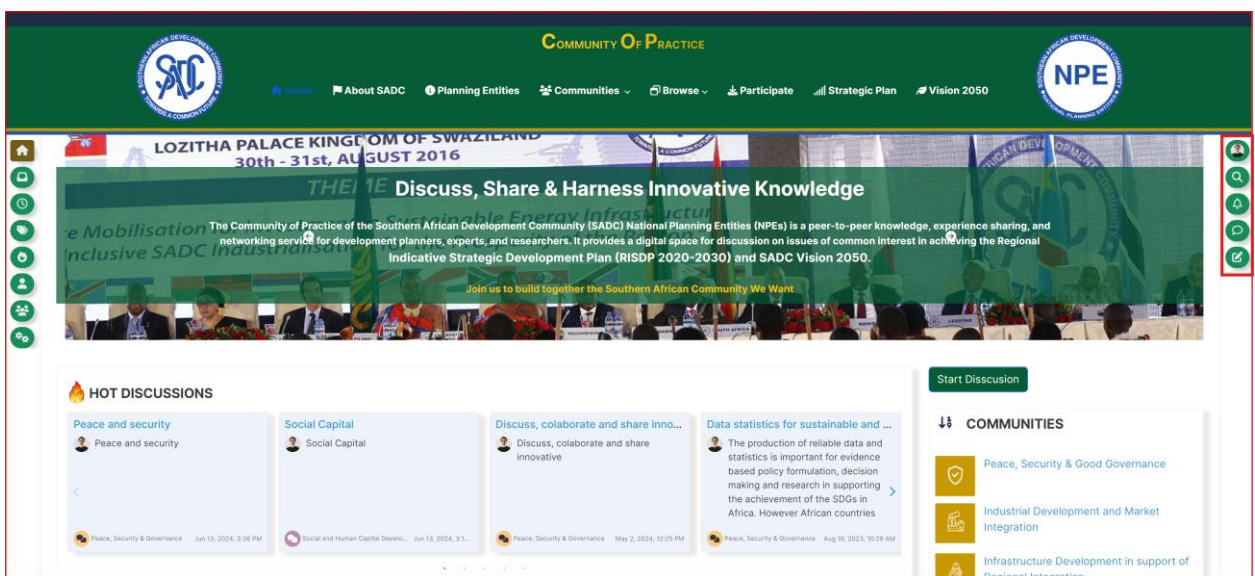




Figure 4-9 Menu

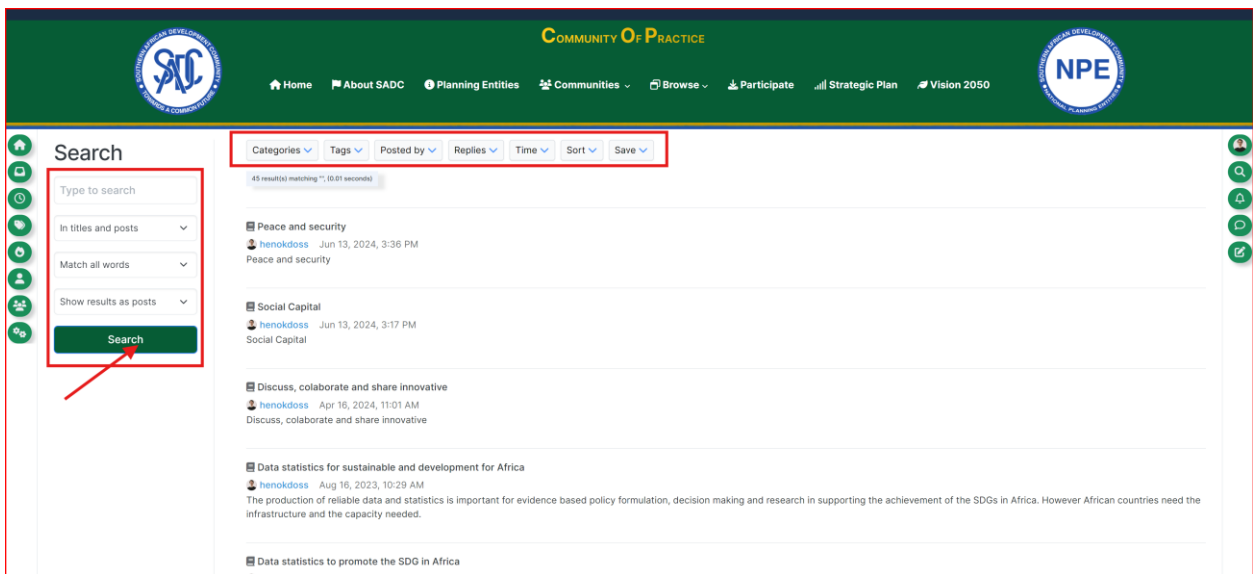



Figure 4-10 Search

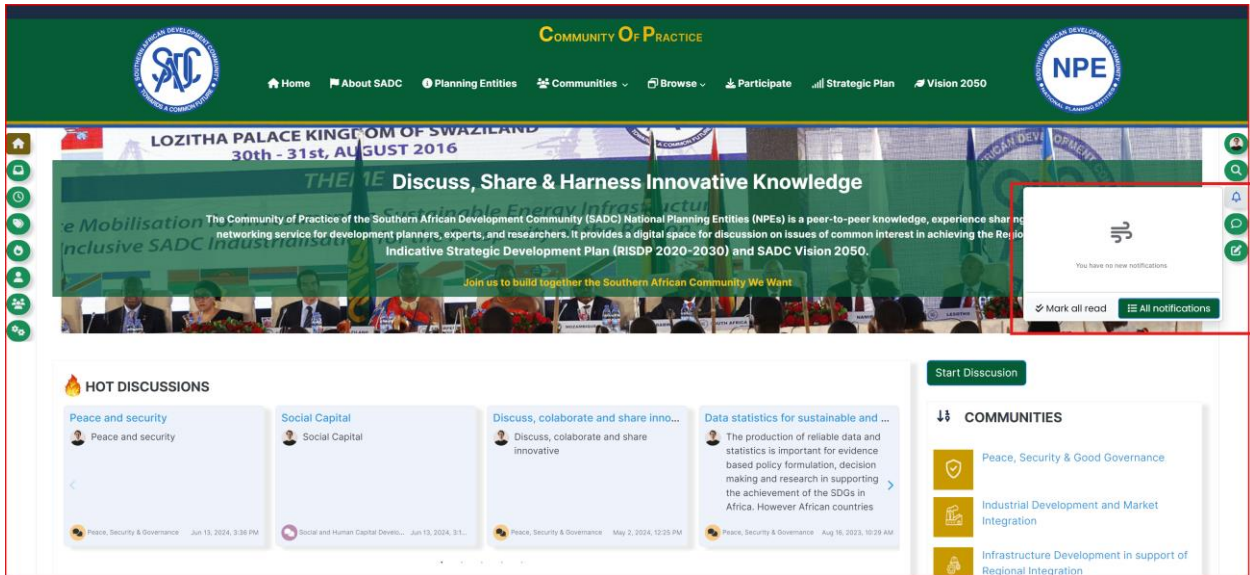



Figure 4-11 Notification

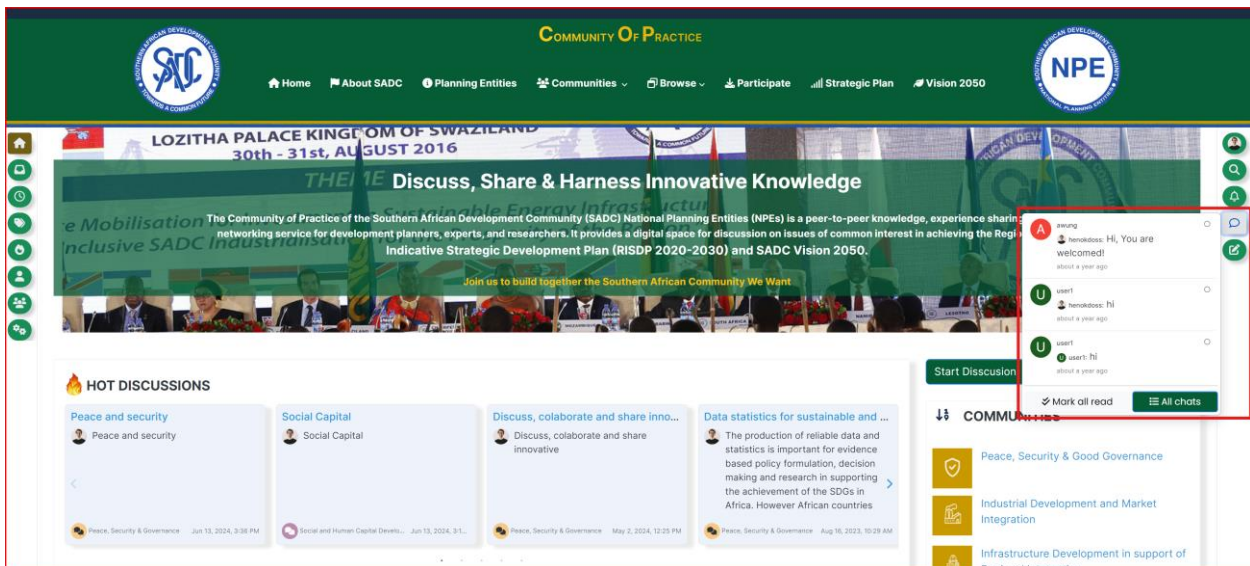




Figure 4-12 Chat

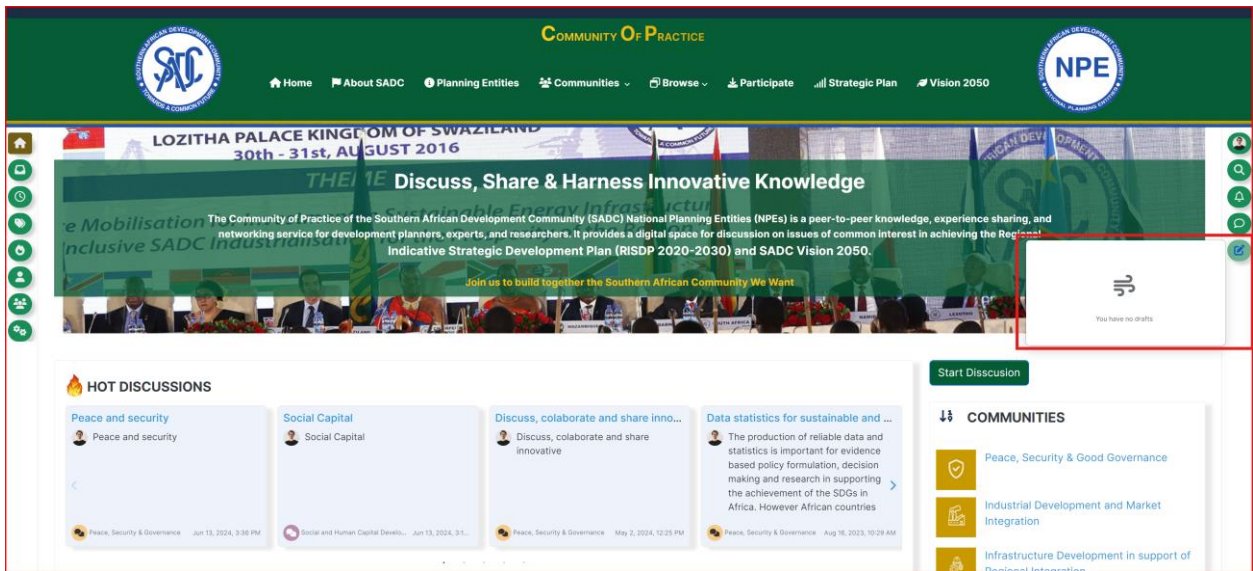


Figure 4-13 Draft

About South Africa

The Republic of South Africa joined the Southern African Development Community (SADC) as the 11th Member State in April 1994 and attended the SADC Summit for the first time in August 1994. A statement of accession to the SADC Treaty was delivered by the then Vice President of the country, Thabo Mbeki, marking a major milestone for regional integration, after a long process in which the SADC Region was at the centre.

South Africa occupies the southern-most part of the African continent stretching from the Limpopo River in the north to Cape Agulhas in the south. The country shares borders with Namibia, Botswana to the west, and Zimbabwe in the north, with Eswatini and Mozambique in the north east. It also entirely surrounds the Kingdom of Lesotho. To the west, south and east, South Africa borders the Atlantic and southern Indian oceans.

The country's first democratic elections were held in 1994. Since then, democratic elections are held every five years and the Head of State is the President. The South African economy is the most advanced on the African continent, with a sophisticated financial system that includes one of the top 10 stock exchanges in the world, and well developed physical, telecommunications, and energy infrastructures.

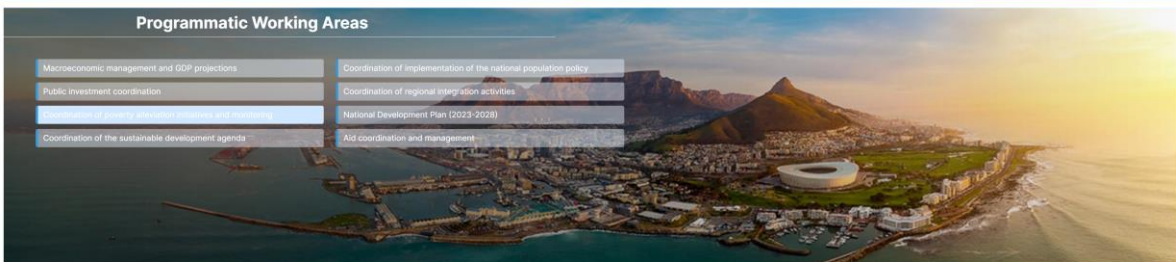


National Planning Entity

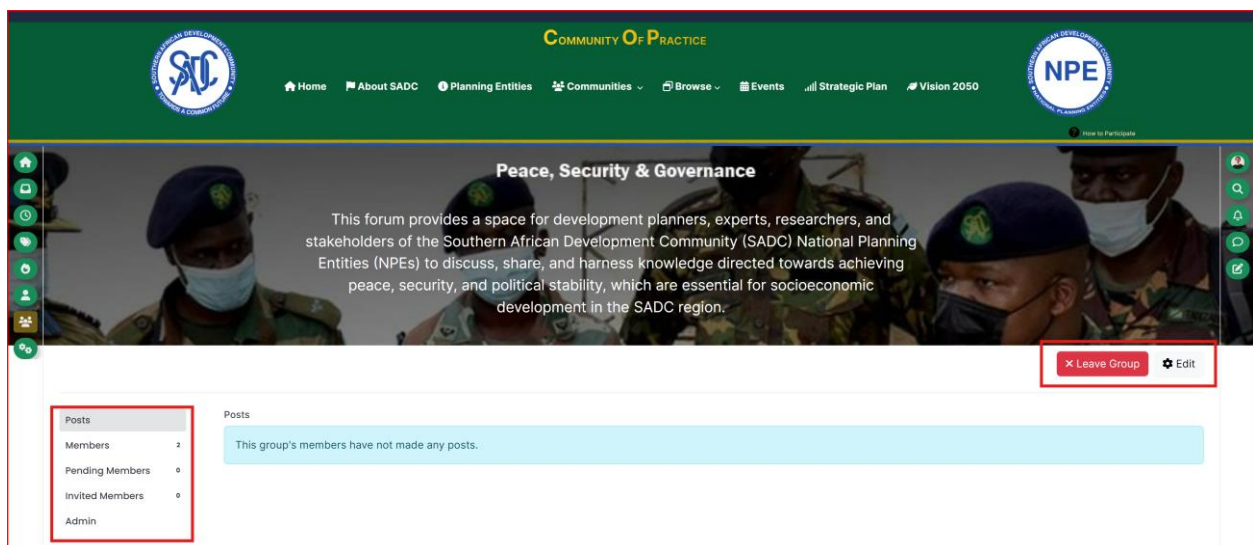



Figure 4-17 Peace, Security & Governance

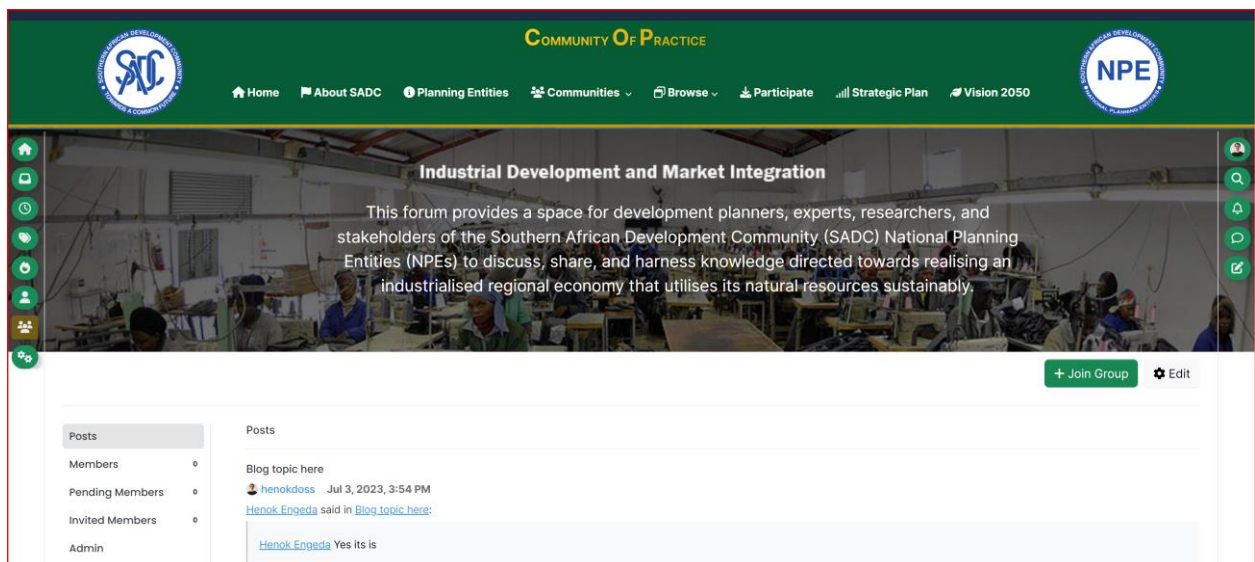



Figure 4-18 Industrial Development & Market Integration

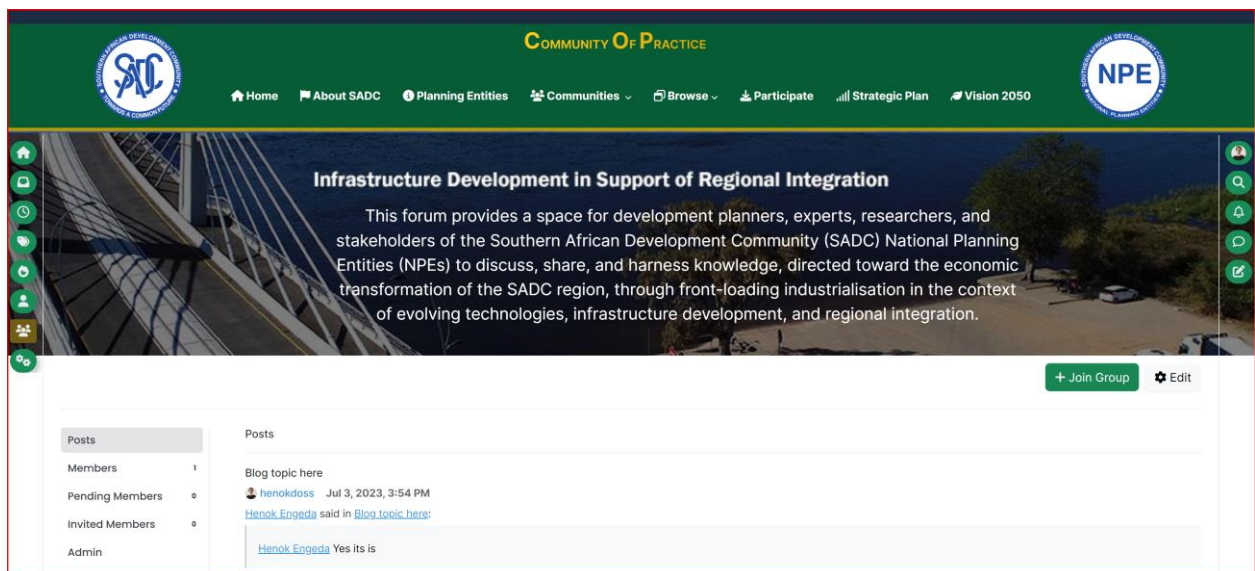



Figure 4-19 Infrastructure Development in Support of Regional Integration

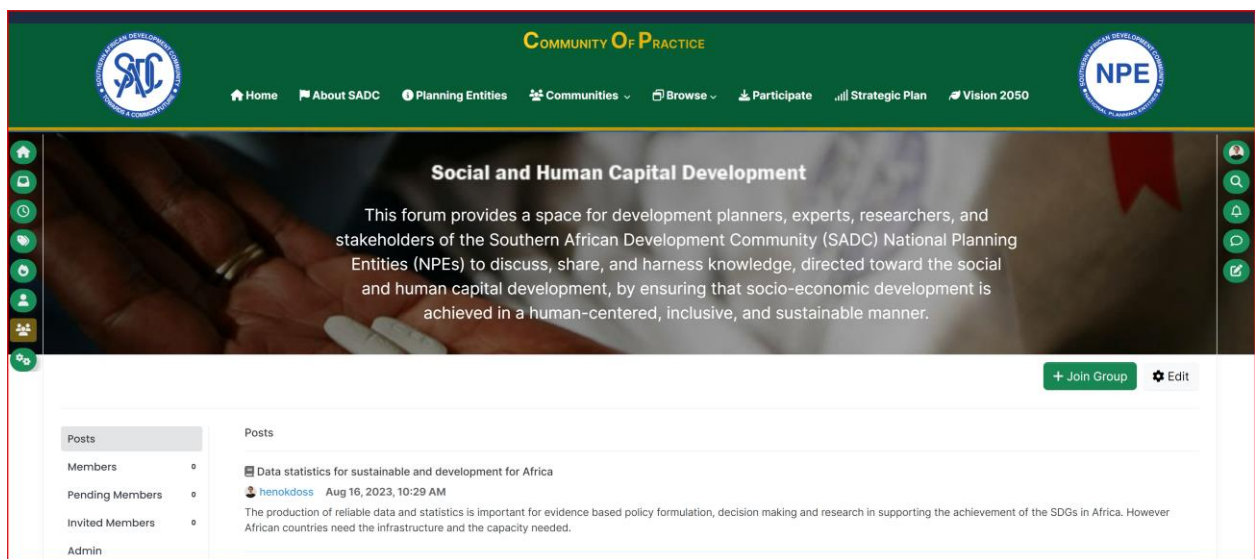


Figure 4-20 Social & Human Capital Development

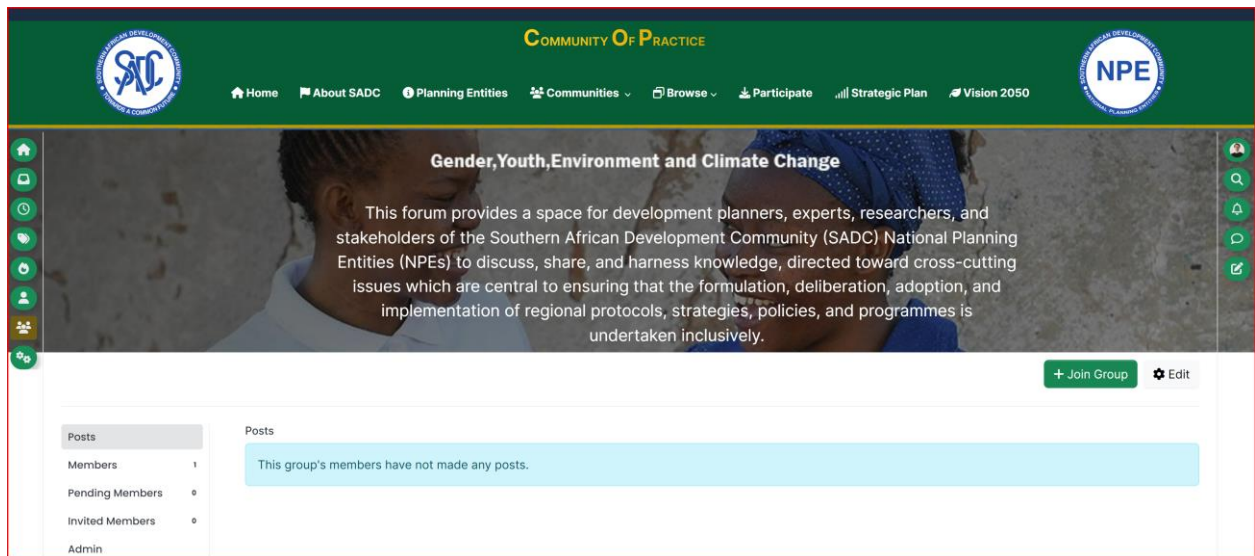


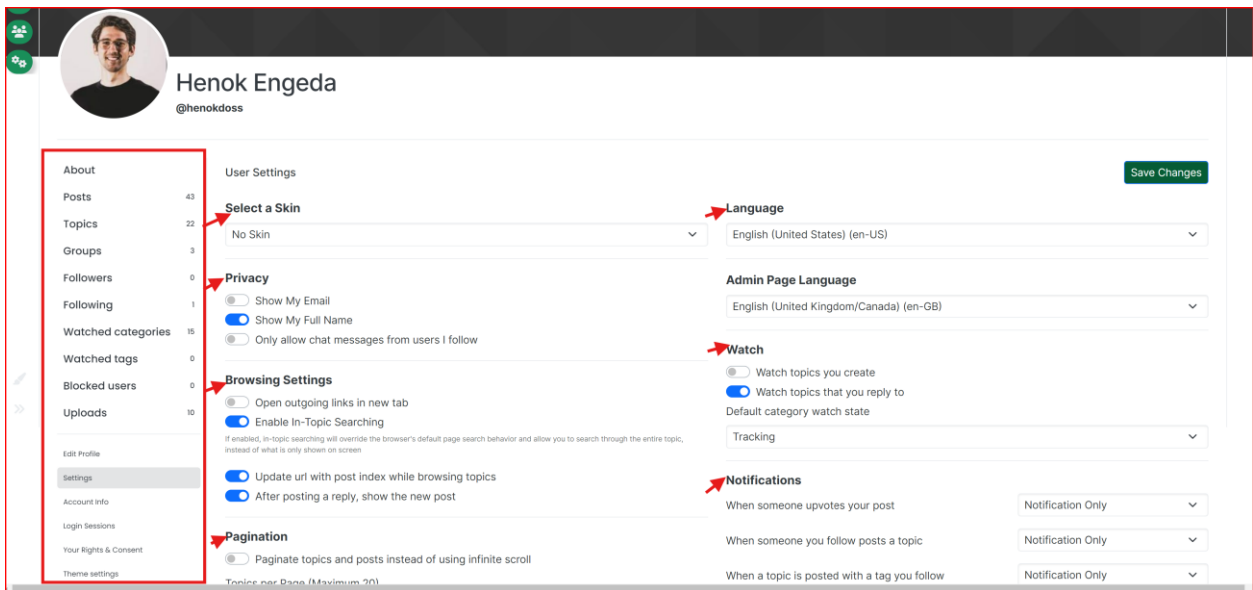
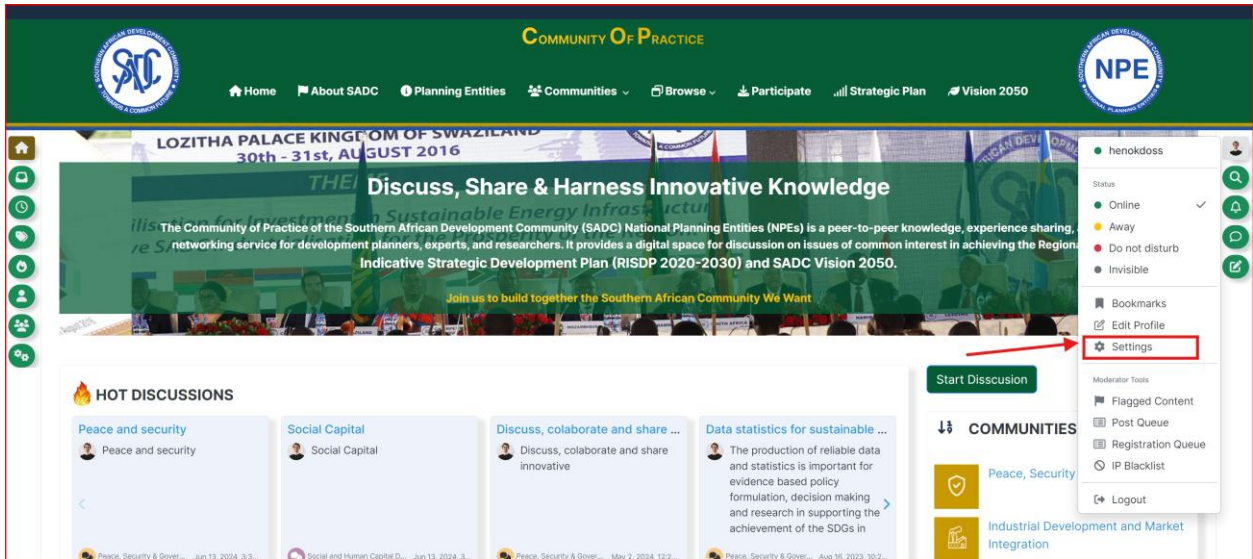
Figure 4-21 Gender Equality & Women Empowerment
